Because God is a just judge, he will have no choice but to punish the guilty.

Even though you have broken God’s holy laws and deserve punishment, God made a way for you to be forgiven through Jesus Christ. If you repent (turn away) from your sins and put your faith and trust in Jesus Christ, God will forgive you and give you eternal life.
