What is a Festival?

Imagine throwing a party and inviting a few thousand friends. Only this party has a purpose—to reach people with the good news of Jesus Christ. That is what **Foundation Ministries Festivals** are all about.

Festivals are open air outreach events designed to mobilize churches to reach their communities with the good news of Jesus Christ. They combine music, food, games, activities and extreme sports with gospel presentations for all ages.



We have reached hundreds of people all over the world in open air campaigns with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Festival is a two day event—Friday and Saturday—with other affinity events scheduled for the week prior to the actual Festival. However, the effects of the Festival outlast the event itself. You can expect:

- Hundreds of believers equipped for friendship evangelism
- Churches experience unity as they work together across denominational and racial barriers to accomplish a common goal—reaching people with the gospel
- Churches and believers engage in concerted prayer efforts as they prepare for Festival events
- Churches grow because of evangelism efforts as we reach the lost and reclaim the backslidden
- Anticipation of the event catches the attention of local media and generates public discussion of the gospel

Typical Timeline

Required planning time frame — minimum of 1 year

- **1 year—10 Months**—Initial contact and vision casting meetings
- **10 Months—8 Months**—Planning team formation and training
- **8 Months**—Fundraising and sponsorship efforts begin
- **8 Months—6 Months**—Arrangements for Festival grounds and facilities
- **6 Months**—Corporate prayer efforts begin through rallies and events
- **6 Months—2 Months**—Preparations for Festival including securing promotional materials completed
- **2 Months**—Counselor training begins. Local church rally with evangelist
- **2 Months to Event**—planning of affinity groups meetings and pre-festival events.
- **Event—2 Months After**—Follow up activities through churches
